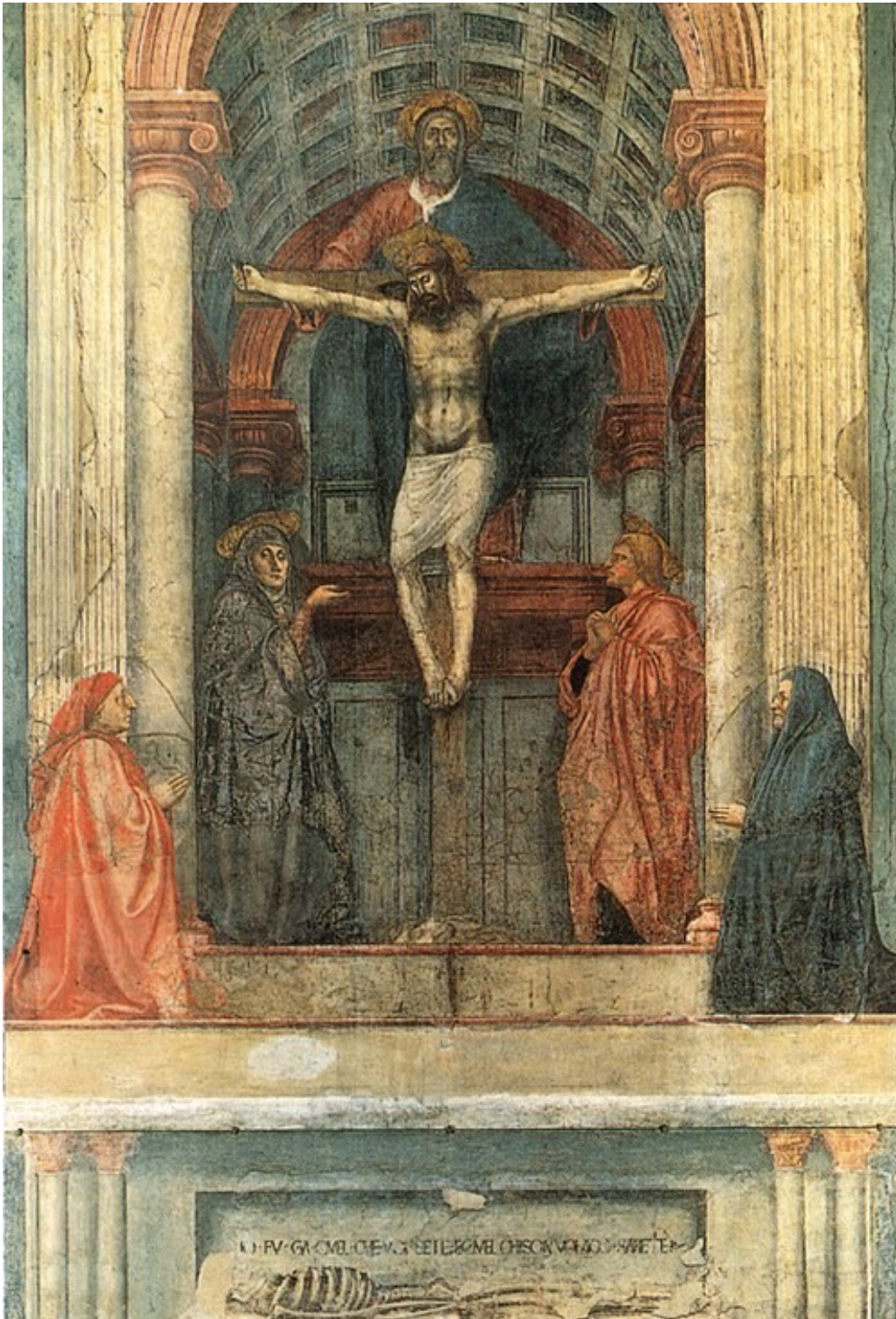

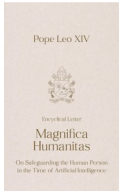
rites of Full Initiation and Full Communion
