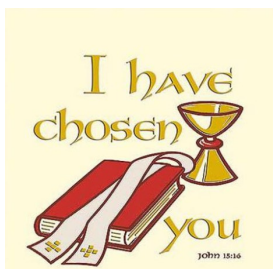
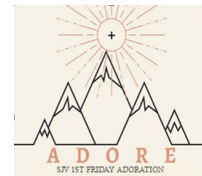

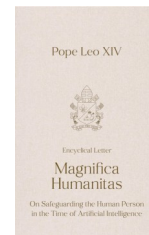

STUDY GROUP ON MAGNIFICA HUMANITAS of His Holiness Pope Leo XIV

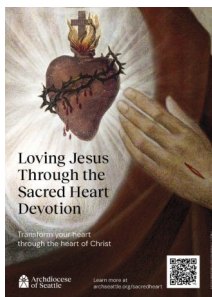
Discussion of Pope Leo’s Encyclical starts after Sunday Mass on June 14. Bring your donut and coffee.
