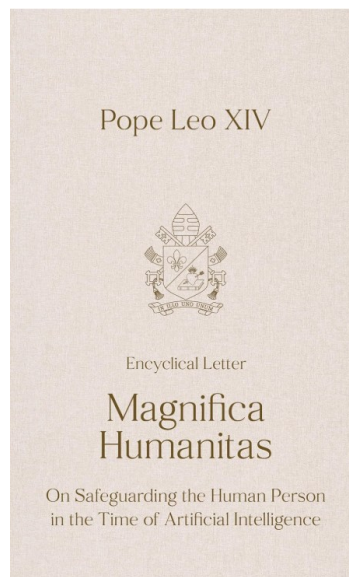
STUDY GROUP ON *MAGNIFICA HUMANITAS* of His Holiness Pope Leo XIV—meeting in one week during Coffee Hour

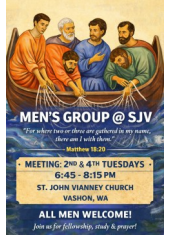
