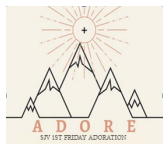

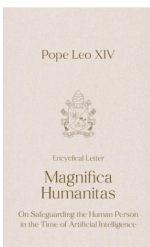

### ST. PATRICK'S SCOUT TROOP 299 DOES VERY NEAT WORK

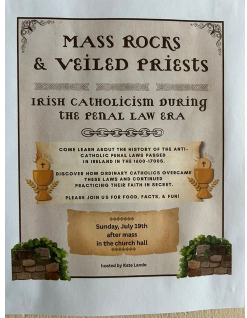

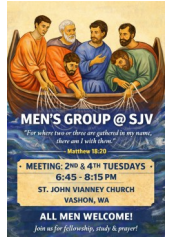
