\$6,242 in pure profit! Our best sale ever. Thank you to all who donated items for the benefit of

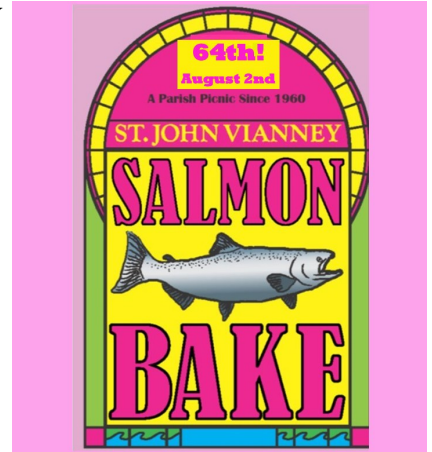

The retreat finishes at our Sunday Mass, so all Sunday attendees will have a chance to welcome them.

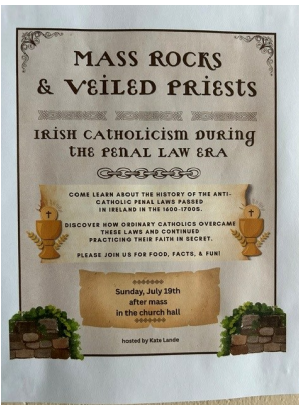


Stewardship of Talent
